As Historians we will be:

- developing an awareness of the past and how toys and games have changed
- identifying similarities and differences between ways of life at different times in history
- asking and answering questions
- using sources such as visits, websites, artefacts and books to research our topic.

As Musicians we will be:

- listening to and appraising different styles of music
- learning to sing a variety of tunes and songs
- learning and performing Christmas songs.

As Sportspeople we will be learning to:

- show a good awareness of others in running, chasing and avoiding games, making simple decisions about when and where to run
- perform dances using simple movement patterns.

As Scientists we will be learning to:

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

In Religious Education we will be talking about:

- special celebrations within our own lives and our community
- the Christmas story.

In Computing we will be learning:

- about the ways in which we can stay safe online
- how to write simple algorithms and know why it is important to be precise when writing one.
- to create and debug simple programs.

As Design Technologists we will be:

- evaluating, making and designing a variety of paper toys
- selecting from and using a wide range of materials, components and tools.

As good citizens we will be:

- what a community is and how we belong to our school community,
- about the wider communities to which we belong (home/family and local community).
